

EDUCATION SECTION BUSINESS MEETING
CLINICAL EDUCATION SECTION BREAKOUT MEETING
ANNUAL CONFERENCE 2003
June 21, 2003

- I. INTRODUCTION: Present: Outgoing CCCE Co-Chair Patty Trela, Current Membership Secretary Jenny Rodriguez, Outgoing Nominating Committee Chair Renee Stolove, Current Nominating Committee Chair Teri Stumbo, Incoming Nominating Committee Gina Musolino, And Incoming Recording Secretary Alecia Thiele Absent: Current ACCE Co-Chair Peggy Gleeson, Incoming CCCE Co-Chair Heidi Dunfee, Outgoing Recording Secretary Noreen Clouton. The attendance records were signed by 11 persons.

- II. BRAINSTORMING: The Executive Committee brainstormed ideas of ways to include more members in the Clinical Education SIG, and possible clinical education SIG course offerings at their meeting earlier in the day. The brainstorming session was carried over to this informal Education Section Business Meeting Clinical Education SIG Breakout Session. The following ideas were brought forth by the attendees at the session.
 - A. Ways to include more members in the Clinical Education SIG:
 - i. Foster more clinician recognition awards
 - ii. Foster sponsorship/membership to the Education Section and Clinical Education SIG
 - iii. Letter of congratulations to the winner of the Clinical Educator Award (Jenny Rodriguez offered to send the letter on behalf of the SIG)
 - iv. Tie Education Section and Clinical Education SIG membership to the ability to attain library or Medline articles and reference materials.
 - v. Aim more programming towards clinical education specifically clinical educators at national conferences (see B below)

 - B. Suggestions for topics to consider for future programming for annual and others to encourage participation by the clinical education community for conference offerings:
 - i. Expectations of DPT students; CI's are confused about this issue as their credentials might be at MPT, MS, BS or certificate levels and they do not have a clear understanding of their ability to evaluate DPT students. This discussion would also include working on discussions related to the evolution of practice by using the CPI and how to address evaluation of areas on the CPI that are frequently marked as N/A.
 - ii. Courses related to levels of practice; These courses would address the gap areas of prior educational levels with the Guide and CPI as somewhat stated previously.

- iii. Professionalism; Professionalism as it specifically relates to clinical education
- iv. Structure of Clinical Education; How to structure more intermediate and advanced levels of clinical education. Clinical Educators know how to work with early internships, but they could use more guidance on advanced and intermediate internship levels
- v. Update Courses; Courses related to the evolving clinical outcomes and revised CPI.
- vi. Panel Discussion; Discussions of complex challenges in clinical education with several seasoned CI credentialed instructors, seasoned ACCE/DCE/CCCE's, and possibly recent graduates. Also presentations of several "cases" from clinical education with time for the panel and audience to address discussions.
