WORKSHOP GOALS

Upon completion of this workshop, the participant should be able to:

- Formulate a personal and professional development plan that balances academic, personal, and professional responsibilities in the areas of teaching, creative activity, and service in the academic environment;
- Integrate ethical standards of behavior and positive role modeling within the academic environment;
- Construct a plan for positioning in the academic environment which allows future growth;
- Value the benefits of collegial relationships;
- Appreciate and accommodate the differences in learning styles in the millennial generation of students;
- Develop a course including outline, objectives, syllabus, and evidence-based evaluation methods;
- Design and assemble a portfolio to document the scholarship of teaching and learning; and
- Evaluate service learning activities as effective teaching strategies.

The primary audience for the workshop will be full-time faculty members who are in the first 4 years of a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant faculty appointment.
